







The geography of an area

Figure 1.1 West Midlands sub-regional housing market areas







Government's response to the Heseltine review

- Local authorities must "co-ordinate land use planning functions and align adopted local plans, including the use of local development orders, across local authorities in a LEP area".
- The plans must also show "effective pooling of economic development spend and functions across the LEP area" and "a co-ordinated approach to strategic spatial planning".
