Brexit the major political challenge – but existing domestic concerns fought back during the campaign



## Housing remains important

#### **Younger voters**

- The young predominantly voted Labour
- Home ownership among the young has fallen dramatically
- Increasing percentage living in private rented
- Majority voted Labour

#### **Older voters**

- The old predominantly voted Conservative
- It is only among the over 60s that home ownership levels are still rising
- But a shortage of specialist housing to meet the needs of older people
- Majority voted Conservative
