





Housing remains one of the main domestic issues












- When we're through the current political stasis.....

- Articulating a positive housing offer will be an electoral battleground










For younger generations home ownership is not an easily achievable aspiration






Political context – tenure voting trends








Summary of the political stakes

- A housing offer for younger generations in particular key part of electoral strategy




Government has felt the pressure and transmitting this to industry

Post Brexit – Government may



- Introduce new stimulus measures
- If so:
 - will increase the political stakes
 - put more pressure on delivery
 - sharpen the need to tackle challenges and image issues
- Future migration regime a key issue for industry – 18% of workforce EU nationals

Government committed to increasing supply

Policy environment remains generally favourable

Funding in place for Help to Buy 1 and 2 to continue until 2023
